LADIES CLASS

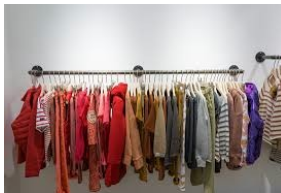
Ladies class will resume Tuesday morning at 10:00 a.m. in room 28/29.
