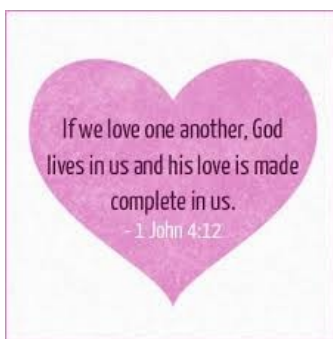


## ROOTED STUDENT MINISTRIES
