MENS PRAYER BREAKFAST

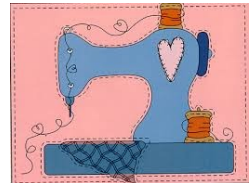
There will be a prayer breakfast in the MPB on April 9 at 8:00 AM for all the men. Make plans to come and enjoy some great home cooking!
