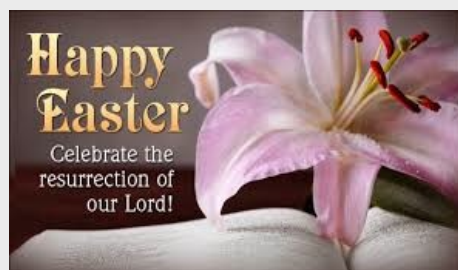

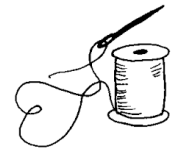
## GOSPEL MEETINGS
