NURSERY FACILITIES

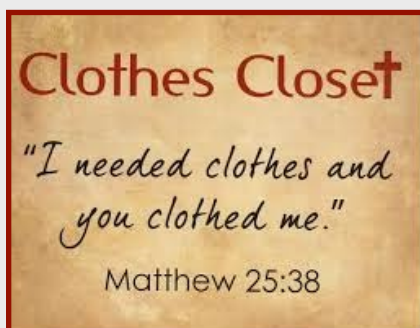
An attended nursery is available on the west side of the foyer for infants through two years.
