There will be a meeting for all the **Elders, Deacons** and **Ministers** on Tuesday, January 23, at 7:00 p.m. in room 28/29.

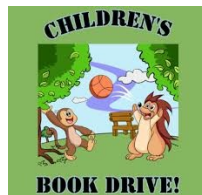
