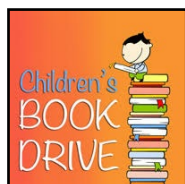

BOOK DRIVE FOR CHILDREN'S HOME IN INDIA

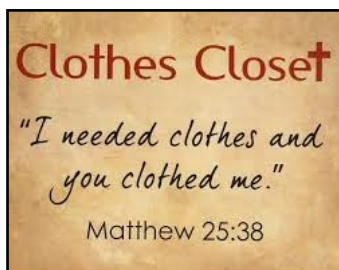
