Tim Dobbs will be preaching today and next Sunday. We appreciate his willingness to preach for us while he is home from India.

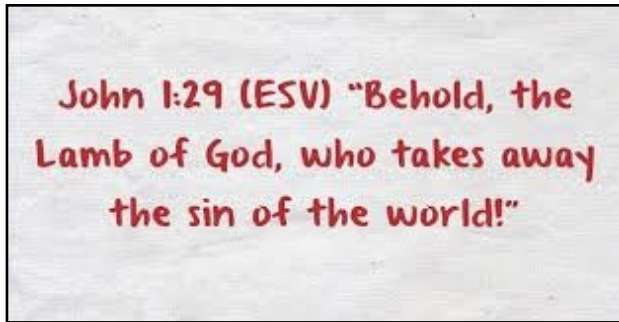
