NURSERY FACILITIES

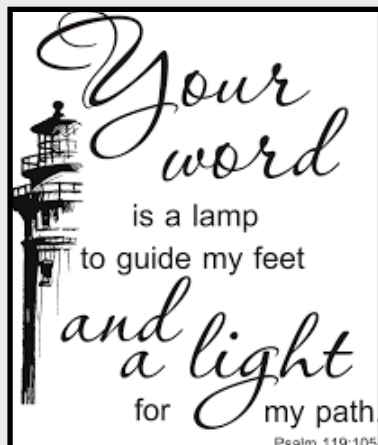
An attended nursery is not available at this time. Facilities are located on the west side of the foyer. Parents may take their own children to the nursery if they choose.

The truck will be here Wednesday to pick up the change cans and Cheez Its. Please place your items in the foyer or drop them by the office. Thanks for supporting the children.

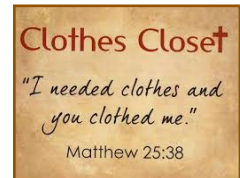
