Today will be the last opportunity to sign the books.

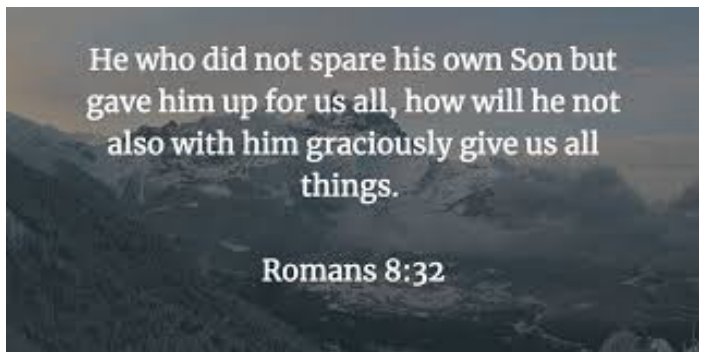
